
Winter Break is almost here!

CCPS Inclement Weather Notifications (information worth repeating)

Earlier this week, CCPS sent out an email regarding Inclement Weather Notifications. As the weather continues to get colder and in preparation for snow, it is important to be familiar with the "must knows"

What do I need to know?

-The most reliable sources of school closing information are the school system's 24-hour information line, website at <u>www.ccboe.com</u>, official social media pages, and email and text message notificatinos sent by CCPS to both parents and staff. The 24-hour information line is 301-934-7410 or 301-932-6656.

-Parents who want to receive these updates by text MUST opt-in by texting Y or YES to 67587. For parents, a cell phone number must be listed on the child's student information record at school. The system used by CCPS to send text messages pulls cell phone data from the student and staff information databases.

-Please do no rely on news and radio station annoucments for closing and delay information, they can often report inaccurate information they are gathering from sources other than offical CCPS communications. (This occurred on Channel 7 News earlier this week when they reported CCPS were opening two-hours late. This information was not correct.)

-The school system does not make any operating status announcements when schools and offices are open for normal business. Any time there is a schedule change, CCPS shares such updates by email and text to parents and staff; posts to <u>www.ccboe.com</u>; shares on offical CCPS social medial accounts; records a message on the 24-hour information line, and sends an email and text to CNS subscribers.
